

The Meaford Hall & Culture Foundation was created in 2006 as a vehicle to raise the outstanding funds required for the completion of the Meaford Hall renovation. In 2018, the organization rebranded as the Meaford Culture Foundation to reduce public confusion between our Foundation and the Meaford Hall Arts and Cultural Centre. MCF is a vibrant not-for-profit, independent, charitable organization dedicated to the preservation and advancement of arts and culture in our community. Staffed entirely by volunteers, it raises funds for capital projects for The Meaford Hall Arts and Cultural Centre and to our Community Outreach programs which support a wide range of local arts and culture activities. Since its inception, MCF has donated over \$654K to Meaford Hall improvements, and over \$300K towards local arts and cultural initiatives!





MCF's annual fundraising efforts rely almost exclusively on the generous support of our patrons, our donors, and those who simply embrace and support our community arts and culture. In addition to the tax receipt, for the community minded, there are some intangible benefits from donating to the Foundation.
