

MEAFORD INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL 2023

2023 marks the 17th anniversary of the *Meaford Culture Foundation*, a not-for-profit, independent, charitable organization dedicated to the preservation and advancement of arts and culture in our community. Staffed entirely by volunteers, The Foundation raises funds that are allocated for improvements to *The Meaford Hall Arts and Cultural Centre* and to our *Community Outreach* programs which support a wide range of local arts and culture activities. *This includes all funds raised at the annual Meaford International Film Festival*. Since 2006, MCF has allocated over \$654K to Meaford Hall, and over \$268K towards local cultural initiatives!

Meaford Hall Capital Investments

The Foundation has made good use of the funds it has raised – see the list starting on page 2 for funding invested in the Meaford Hall Arts and Cultural Centre. These improvements have helped the Municipal Staff, who run the Meaford Hall, to offer bigger, better and more diverse functions and activities. In addition, Meaford Hall plays a pivotal role as the venue for the clubs, groups, and organizations that benefit from our annual *Community Outreach* grants and bursaries. MCF recently committed 65K for a new film projector, tech equipment and outdoor sign. Full list is attached.

Community Outreach Program

The Foundation has, over the past 14 years, been increasing funding for community arts and culture activities through our Community Outreach program. MCF strives to provide ongoing support to various Community cultural projects with an emphasis on youth. Your dollars and volunteer hours are helping youngsters of all ages accrue the real benefits associated with their exposure and involvement in arts and culture and to level the playing field for families in need. However, this year we are pleased to report that local children have been enthusiastically participating in our "after school" music program. We are once again contributing to the Municipal summer arts camps for youth. Additionally, we are in the process of creating scholarships for students pursuing a study in the Arts & Culture fields. Students from Meaford and the Town of Blue Mountains benefit from our Outreach Programs
